SHOTS FIRED SAFETY RULES

- 1. ALWAYS consider the firearm loaded.
- 2. ALWAYS enter Shots Fired with the gun unloaded and the breach open. If your weapon is in a case or holster, the weapon, under no circumstances, can be loaded. Be prepared to immediately show the SHOTS FIRED staff that your weapon is unloaded with an open breach.
- 3. All children must be at least 13 years of age in order to enter the gun range. Children between the ages of 13 to 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. ALL children between the ages of 13 to 18 must be closely supervised at all times.
- 4. First time shooters are highly encouraged to enroll and participate in our beginner's class.
- 5. ALWAYS point the gun toward the rubber trap.
- 6. ALWAYS keep your trigger finger outside the trigger guard until the barrel of the gun is pointed toward the rubber trap. DO NOT fire your weapon until you are 100% ready to shoot.
- 7. ALWAYS be aware of your complete surroundings in and out of the gun range.
- 8. Gun range eye wear and ear wear must be worn at all times while in the vestibule and in the gun range.
- 9. While in the gun range, only one firearm can be shot at a time. Upon completion of shooting one firearm, the firearm must be unloaded and cased before using another weapon.
- 10. All shooters must fire at their own assigned target in their particular lane.
- 11. Extreme caution is required when firing the weapon in rapid fashion. DO NOT jeopardize the safety of other shooters, yourself or Shots Fired equipment. Shots Fired reserves the right to ask shooters to leave, without a refund, in the event the shooter becomes careless or dangerous.
- 12. Customers that are suspected of alcohol or drug use, will be asked to leave immediately. Drug or alcohol use prior to, or during, entering Shots Fired is strictly prohibited.
- 13. Once inside the range, NO use of cellular or text communication is allowed.
- 14. The use of gum, tobacco, food or drink is not allowed in the range.
- 15. We do not allow drawing from your holster and firing.
- 16. Range Safety Rules must always be followed. If the staff instructs the shooters to cease fire, immediately cease fire, place your firearm on the front shelf and back away from the booth. Upon instruction from the Shots Fired staff, the shooter can enter the booth and commence firing again.
- 17. Any unsafe shooter is to be reported to the Shots Fired staff.
- 18. Tracer rounds, steel jacketed rounds, steel core rounds and all incendiary rounds are NOT allowed at any time. If a customer shoots an unsafe round that is not allowed, the customer will be immediately, removed from the facility and will immediately pay a \$5,000.00 fine. In the event a non-permitted round is fired that results in an injury or death of any individual or person, you will be subject to maximum criminal charges.
- 19. ALL safety rules are to be followed and implemented at all times.
- 20. Once your brass is discharged from your weapon, the brass belongs to Shots Fired.
- 21. It is the sole responsibility of the Shots Fired staff to maintain safety. Shots Fired Staff has the responsibility to remove any customer practicing unsafe firearms procedures.
- 22. I COMPLETELY UNDERSTAND THE ABOVE SAFETY RULES AND WILL FOLLOW AND OBEY ALL RULES.
